

Nourishing the Future: Habema Task Force Provides Free Nutritious Meals for Children in Papua Mountains

NDUGA- In a heartwarming effort to support government initiatives, the Infantry Battalion Task Force (Satgas Yonif) Raider 503/Mayangkara, under the HABEMA Operations Command, held a **Free Nutritious Meal Program** for children at Rimba School, Mumugu Village, Krepkuri District, Nduga, Papua Mountains Regency, on Sunday (02/02/2025). This initiative aligns with the **RI-PNG Mobile Border Security Operation**, currently being carried out in Central Papua's Puncak Regency.

The free nutritious meal program, which has been successfully implemented in various regions of Indonesia, inspired the **Yonif 503/Mayangkara Task Force** to bring the same initiative to their assignment area in the highlands of Papua.
